- 5 Read the following passage carefully and answer the questions that follow :

Atomic energy is obtained from the atom. We can obtain energy from an atom in two ways. Fusion and fission. When one single atom is made out of two atoms is called 'fusion'. Fusion releases a great amount of heat. When one atom is split into two, it is called "fission". This is done by hitting atoms with neutrons. A neutron is a particle in an atom.

When uranium 235 is hit with a neutron, it breaks into two fragments. One kilogram of U-235 gives energy which is 10,00,000 times of energy as obtained by burning one kilogram of coal. A small piece of uranium could run a generator, A heavy train, a steamer or even a jet plane. Atomic energy is the chief source of energy today and in future.
